I have probably broken the record in Taiwan Toastmasters history in terms of spending the longest time for achieving the DTM award, which is only a negative example and is nothing to brag about. In the wake of the upcoming Pathways program launch this May, I shall commit myself to accomplishing all requirements for a second DTM at a much faster speed. In the mean time, I will also devote myself in motivating fellow Toastmasters for developing their potentials.

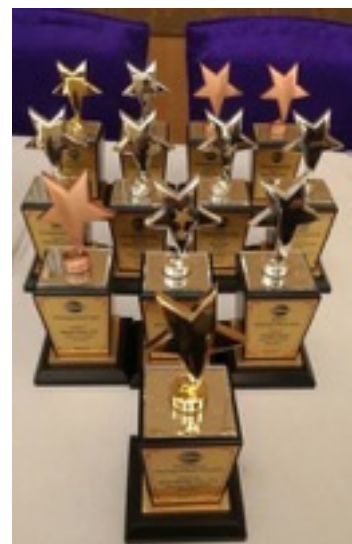

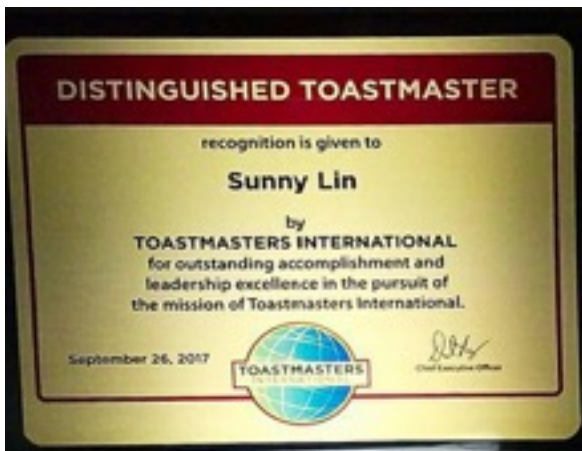


Sunny Lin, DTM

Public speaking could actually scare me to death. However, it's extremely unbelievable that I've eventually achieved DTM!!

Toastmasters does change me better. Last April, I gave a speech at my son's wedding banquet. It particularly surprised those relatives and friends who had not seen me for years. They whispered to each other, "That's marvelous! She's a new Susan!" Interestingly, their words surprised me as well. I giggled and asked myself, "Am I that different?" Yeah! I'm supposed to be more spontaneous in public now.

It was these words that triggered my ambition to break through, and I eventually made up my mind to join as a member of Fengyuan Toastmasters Club, FYTC, in 1996. I once lost interest and stopped doing speeches for years. If it were not for James Lin, ex-district director, and Andrew M. Bott, FYTC ex-president's encouragement and tips of doing speeches, I wouldn't get back to do my speeches, not to mention achieving DTM.

With Andrew's guidance, I started to repeat the same speech at different clubs' meetings, FYTC, MGTC and TEATC, the 3 clubs I belong to. By doing so, I found it fun to deliver speeches because I always did better for the second time. Meanwhile, amazingly, I also became more in control while answering table topics, evaluating speeches, and even playing other roles. Specials thanks to Andrew and James for helping me find a way out. They showed Toastmasters spirit, "Friends help friends to succeed", the final strength that pulled me to reach DTM.

Celebrating Special Achievements Diana Watson 唐華瑄

Q: What was your reaction to seeing your video break a million views and be covered by different news outlets? What are your next steps from here?

A: When I reached the half-million mark, I was the number one video on YouTube in Taiwan that day. Surprisingly, I felt very humble. At 25 or even 35 I would have been jumping up and down throwing a wild party getting my thang on! But life is full of ups and downs. One day you are on top and the next day you can be at the bottom. That day I thought of all the people who believed I could do it, and the people who didn't believe I could do it. I also thought of all the people who thought it was stupid to spend so much time delivering speeches for free, being very active in Toastmasters, and learning Chinese at such an old age. I was basically being different and doing things differently. It takes an inner belief and drive to keep following your dreams when no one pays you. Everyone will think you're stupid. But NEVER listen to naysayers! Why? Because the payment day always comes. For me, it took 10 years of almost no pay and a lot of hard work with few people believing in what I was doing. So believe in yourself and keep working, but remember it doesn't happen overnight!

I have been teaching for almost 20 years and I love it. But I feel like my time as a traditional teacher will be coming to an end. For the next chapter of my life I hope to become a full-time inspirational speaker and design a specialized foreign language public speaking program called The Speaking Seed. I believe that people who share their stories and beliefs in other languages can impact our world exponentially and persuade those in power to implement change. As a Speaking Seed myself, I used my speech, "Am I Strange?", as one of the first foreign language speeches to express the importance of Taiwanese people understanding foreigners, namely black people. Who knew that a little black girl from Philadelphia could one day deliver a funny speech in Mandarin, have over a million views, and hopefully altered the minds of how blacks are perceived?! This is the power of a Speaking Seed!

答：破五十萬點閱的時候，我上了YouTube那天的發燒排行榜第一名。我卻覺得非常謙卑。就算第25或35名我都要跳上跳下開趴慶祝了！然而人生充滿起伏，今天得意，或許隔天就跌落谷底。那天，我想到所有相信我做得到的人，還有不相信我能力的人。也想到所有覺得我很愚蠢的人，他們認為我花這麼多時間免費演講，積極參與演講協會，又年紀這麼大才學中文。我基本上就是跟大家不同，做事方法不同。沒人付錢給你的時候，你需要內在的信念和動力來支持自己追夢。所有人都覺得你傻。但絕對不要聽那些反對派的話！為什麼？因為付款日總會來臨。對我來說，我花了十年時間，近乎無酬，投入大量心力，只有少許人相信我所投入的事情。所以，相信自己，持續努力，但要記得這決不是一夕成就的事情！

教學將近二十年，我喜愛教學。但我覺得最終，我的傳統教師之路會劃上句點。人生下個章節，我希望擔任全職的激勵型講員，並設計一套專門的外語演講計畫名為「演講種子」(The Speaking Seed)。

我相信使用外語分享故事和信念的人能夠大大影響世界，並說服有權者採取行動。作為一顆演說種子，我用我的演講〈我很奇怪嗎？〉來拋磚引玉，表達台灣人了解外國人，在此指黑人，的重要性。誰知道一位來自美國費城的黑人女孩有一天會用中文發表幽默演說，破百萬點閱，而且很可能改變了大眾對黑人的觀感？這就是演說種子的威力！

Breaking through your limit is a way to generate your creativity

After taking this challenge, I found even if I did not speak Taiwanese very well, thinking outside my own box can help me understand multiple ways of communication and even develop my new speech style in Taiwanese.

A journey of a thousand miles begins with a single step.

Stage time is the best treasure in Toastmaster. I am so lucky to use my stage time well during the meetings and sharpen my communication skills of manuals. They are basic trainings to go to the big stage and also help improve your stage manner a lot.

Practice makes perfect.

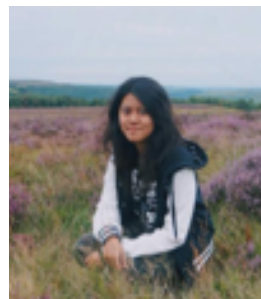
